## Tour of the Ted Davis Auto Collection By Jeff Hand

On February 1, 2025, 35 COJA members and guests descended upon Ted Davis's car collection for a personal tour from Ted Davis of his auto collection. As expected, this collection exceeded our expectations.

Ted was a car guy before he was born and at age ten was working at his father's auto mechanic shop. His grandfather had an auto mechanics shop in Terra Haute Indiana. Later Ted brought his grandfather's auto mechanic shop to OKC and it became a part of his collection.



Half of the tools in the shop were for wood working. That fact dates the shop because the cars repaired at that time were made partly of wood.



Each car in Ted's collection had a story, about the manufacturer, the previous owners, how the car was built and tested, and how it worked. His blue 1915 Packard had a 6-cylinder 415 cubic inch engine that delivered 48 hp. Both of his Marmon luxury cars were test driven at the Indianapolis Brickyard at 100 mph before they were deemed ready for sale by the manufacturer.

Ted had restored a 1903 4-cylinder Packard Grey Wolf specifically designed to go as fast as possible and reached a speed of 77 mph on Daytona Beach. He pointed out a 30-foot-long Bonneville Salt Flats electric car that accelerated from 0-200 mph in 90 seconds and held the world speed record for electric cars.

He is currently building a 1933 front wheel drive Miller race car. Miller never built the car but Ted got the drawings and he is building it from scratch.

We saw a Mercer race car and his original 1911 Franklin race car equipped with an aircooled engine that participated in the Los Angeles to Phoenix Desert Race 1908 to 1914. The Franklin is the only survivor of

that race.

He knew the history of the owner of his 1932 Packard prototype roadster and

knew in detail what was done that made the car a prototype.

Ted has been to Hershey's in Pennsylvania every year for the past 50 years, taken his cars on tours from Brighten, England to Pebble Beach, California and he shows no sign of slowing down. Ted had a good time as our tour guide and I personally look forward to another tour.
